Terms & Conditions

1. The award will be known as 'Ashtavaidyan Padma Shri E. T. Neelakandhan Mooss Award'.
2. The participant's bio-data should be attached with the paper.
3. The participant should not write their name or make any identification marks in the paper.
4. The essay should be an original work, written in English and not presented elsewhere previously.
5. The essay should be neatly typed in A4 sheets with line spacing of 1.5 using Times New Roman 12 font size on one side of paper preferably with super-scripted references. Any schematic representations may be done on the back side of printed sheet.
6. Ideally the Essay should be of 20 - 30 A4 sheets. The essay shall be in the following format - Introduction, Review of literature, Materials, Discussion, Summary, Conclusion with take home message and Bibliography.
7. The essay should accompany an abstract of the same in approx 300 words with above mentioned specifications. Submission of essay without abstract will not be accepted.
8. The hardcopy of essay should be sent to the below mentioned address superscribing the envelope with 'Vidvatta 2025' on left hand top corner. Soft copy should be sent simultaneously to "vidvatta@vaidyaratnammooss.com"
9. Each participant should give a duly signed undertaking in the form attached.
10. The authors of best three papers from each category will be given an opportunity to present their paper (5+1 mins) on 12th July 2025 and winners will be selected on the basis of total valuation.
11. Entries of UG/PG students should be authorized by the HOD/Principal of the concerned institution.
12. The essay once sent for competition will not be returned.
13. The decision of the award committee will be final in all matters concerned with the competition.
14. The last date for receipt of essay is **15th May 2025**.
